

2011 Pesticide Disposal Program

Localities Include:

Culpeper, Fauquier, Madison, Rappahannock

Virginia Cooperative Extension, Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (VDACS) and the Virginia Pesticide Control Board invite farmers, pesticide dealers, pest control firms, homeowners and golf courses to participate in the 2011 pesticide disposal program, which collects unwanted, outdated, or banned pesticides. **No cost to participants.** Registration fees collected by VDACS fund the program.

Disposal Location: CFC Farm and Home, 15172 Brandy Road, Culpeper

When: October 5, 2011 **Time:** 9am – 1pm

Participants must transport their unwanted pesticides to central collection sites located within the service area. If participants cannot safely containerize the unwanted pesticides for transport, the disposal contractor will make arrangements to do that for them. **Only unwanted pesticides will be accepted.** Pesticide contaminated material (for example, pesticide contaminated fertilizer) will not be accepted as part of the disposal program. In addition, the program **does NOT accept** motor oil, paint, fuel, fertilizer or other chemicals.
